

THE WEDDING FLAG ASSIGNMENT

Prayer flags are inscribed with auspicious symbols, invocations, prayers, and mantras. Tibetan Buddhists for centuries have planted prayer flags outside their homes and places of spiritual practice for the wind to carry the beneficent vibrations across the countryside. Prayer flags are said to bring happiness, long life and prosperity to the flag planter and those in the vicinity.



Borrowing from this tradition, we'd love for ALL GUESTS invited to this event to create their own flags which will be flown at the wedding. When all displayed together, the flags will represent the combined blessings of our entire community of family and friends, those present as well as those unable to join us that day in Texas.

Enclosed in this invitation are flags for you and your guests to inscribe and/or decorate with wishes, blessings, prayers, poems, artwork, or just general thoughts that you'd like to share. We've included some extras in case you want to make more than one (children are welcomed and encouraged to make their own flags too!), or if you don't get your first one quite right. Please sign your flag so that people viewing it at the wedding will know who it's from.

Do not feel limited to just pens and pencils: paint, glue, glitter, stickers, collage, and other media are completely welcome and encouraged. This is not a contest, so don't feel left out if you do not have confidence in your artistic abilities. Simple writing will be just as special to us as a colorful painting.

Please return the completed flags with your Reply Card, and contact us if you need to request more flags for any reason.



TRANSPORTATION

ARRIVAL BY PLANE

We recommend the Austin-Bergstrom International Airport for people flying in and out of town. It's a 30-minute drive or shuttle ride to the downtown hotels where we are suggesting people stay. The Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport is a three-hour drive from Austin, but usually offers more flight options. If you plan to rent a car anyway, you may want to consider this option.

RENTING A CAR?

Guests will not need to rent a car if they are planning on staying at either the Radisson, Embassy Suites, or other hotels nearby in downtown Austin. There are shuttle and taxi services to all hotels downtown from the Austin airport. We will provide free transportation throughout Saturday to and from the wedding site and the Radisson and Embassy Suites hotels. Shuttles will leave these hotels at 11:30 AM and 1:30 PM, and leave The Trois Estate at 7:00 PM, 9:00 PM, and 11:00 PM. Friday night we will be hosting a free dinner for all guests 1 block from the Radisson and 4 blocks from the Embassy Suites.

GETTING TO THE TROIS ESTATE FROM DOWNTOWN

From Loop 360, go west on RR 2222 to City Park Road. Go left on City Park Road 2.8 miles to a "Y" in the road. Turn left on Pearce Road and proceed 1.6 miles to the entrance of Trois Estate. The address is 3612 Pearce Road in Austin, Texas.
